Greetings from Casino Free NH and
Granite State Coalition Against Expanded Gambling!

I'm contacting you because you are on a list that our friend Jim Rubens maintained of supporters of the anti-casino, anti-gambling campaigns in the last several years. As you know, Jim had to step back from the latest effort, but we're hoping you will help us carry on Jim's efforts.

THE SITUATION

As you know, Governor Hassan is leaning on NH Reps to support the HB 1633, known as the "Ames Bill." This bill adds a regulatory structure and espouses a one-casino package designed for one company, Millennium Gaming, and one location, Rockingham Park race track. The bill's siren song of revenue has lured several reps who have voted against casinos in the past to be on the fence.

Granite State Coalition Against Expanded Gambling and Casino Free NH have once again united to fight this and other gambling bills facing the NH House and NH Senate this term. The business plan and concept for this one casino deal is fundamentally flawed in the face of pending Boston and Springfield casinos. And in light of the recent declines in revenue in Connecticut, New York and New Jersey -- and even a state-funded bailout in Delaware -- this couldn't be a worse bet for New Hampshire.

WILL YOU HELP?

We need committed volunteers willing to contact their local representatives by personal phone call or handwritten letter. We need you to tell your story about WHY gambling is bad for New Hampshire in a way that's meaningful to our legislators. The legislators themselves have said that mass emails and emails from outside the district are ineffective, so we're taking a gentle but direct approach.
