I wanted to update the Board of Alderman with what I know or don't know as of this evening regarding Mayor Gatsas and his absence from his duties as mayor following his by-pass surgery.

- The last information I received was the press release Tuesday evening
- Yesterday (Weds.) I reached out to the mayor's office with a phone call and follow-up e-mail (below) requesting an opportunity to speak briefly with the mayor on Friday about how he was feeling and compliance with state law and city charter while he was absent due to his surgery.
- Earlier today, I received a voice mail message (as a follow-up to my e-mail) stating that the mayor would not be able to speak with me until sometime on Monday or Tuesday.
- I got home this evening and there was an e-mail indicating the mayor would like to speak with me between 9am-10am on Friday.

I need to share with the Board of Alderman, my frustration with the lack of information being provided the board. The mayor had major surgery on Tuesday and at no time has there been any communication with the board on the mayor's ability to carry out his duties. This is disrespectful to the Alderman and more importantly to the citizens of Manchester. The people of Manchester deserve better.

I know I speak for all in wishing Mayor Gatsas a speedy recovery. There is an obligation by all elected officials to do what is in the best interest of the people we are elected to represent. That has not happened.
