**ANDREW HEMINGWAY COMMENTS ON HASSAN
APPOINTMENT OF BILL DUNCAN TO BOARD OF EDUCATION**

Manchester, N.H. –Candidate for New Hampshire Governor, Andrew Hemingway, released the following statement on Governor Hassan’s appointment of Bill Duncan to the State Board of Education:
