NHGOP TO HASSAN: WITHDRAW DUNCAN NOMINATION

Concord - New Hampshire Republican State Committee Chairman Jennifer Horn today called on Governor Maggie Hassan to withdraw her nomination of radical anti-school choice activist William Duncan to the State Board of Education:
